

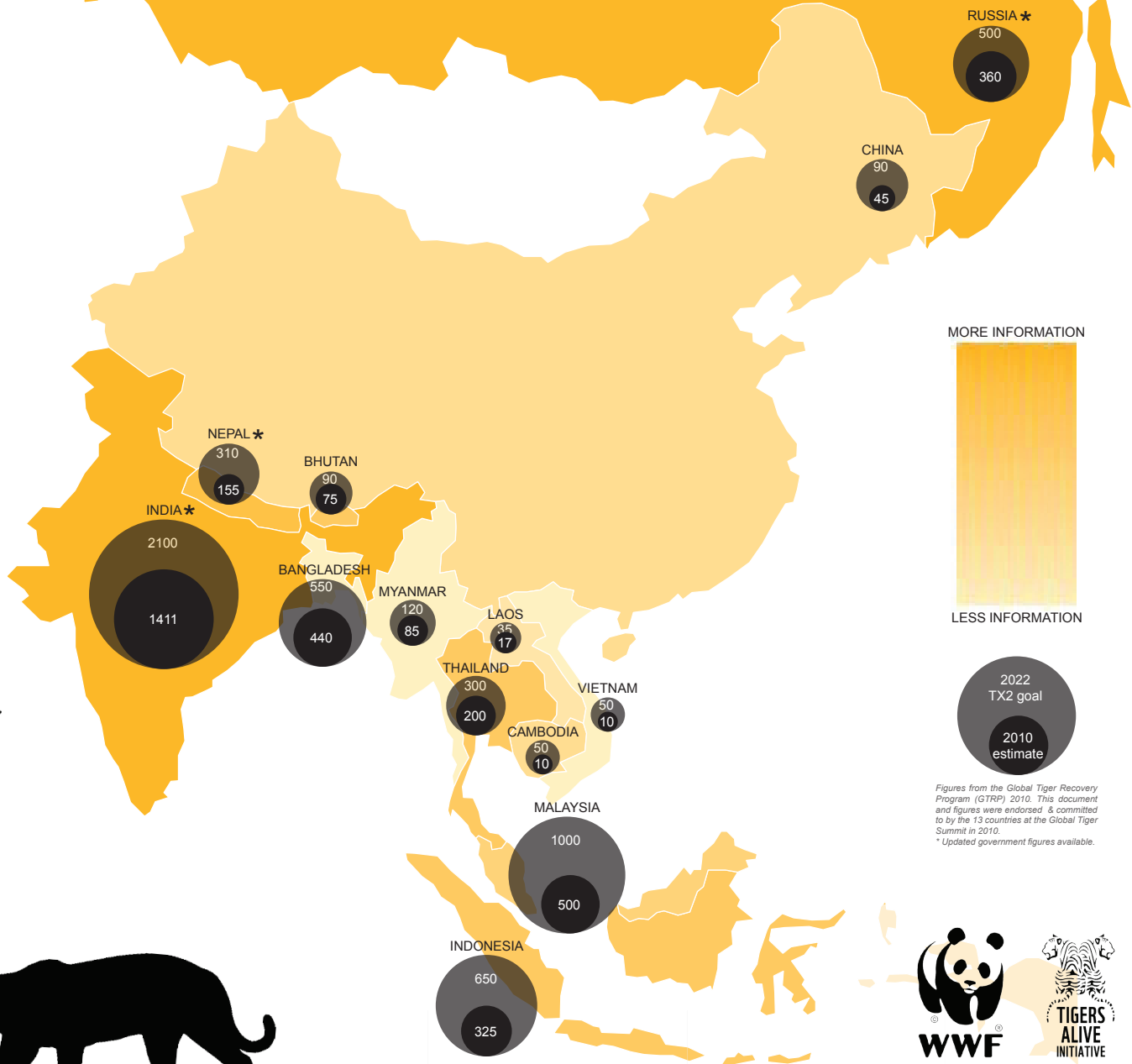
WILD TIGERS SHOULD BE UNDER SURVEILLANCE.

COUNTING TO TX2 IN 2022

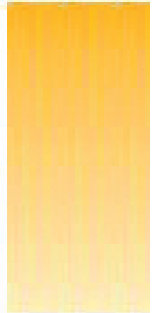
Counting tigers is the only way to track progress toward the global goal of doubling wild tigers by 2022. WWF is calling on the 13 tiger range countries to commit to a series of global tiger surveys and renew their TX2 pledge.

Several countries have already increased survey efforts to gather tiger population data, however others have much less information. Many figures from 2010 were inaccurate; while some baselines and/or targets have been updated (*), others need attention. Scientifically rigorous country-wide surveys will provide critical data to show where countries are moving toward their 2022 commitment or, where necessary, adapting figures to still make TX2 a reality.

Support the global effort to double wild tigers by 2022. Join WWF in calling on these 13 governments to commit to global surveys & updated figures to track the world's progress to tiger recovery.
